The State of Arizona, Department of Insurance ("Department"), has received evidence that Vito B. Gruppuso (Respondent) violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is and was at all material times licensed to transact property and casualty insurance business as a non-resident producer, Arizona license number 33510, which license expires April 30, 2004. Respondent is the principal owner, shareholder and licensed officer of National Program Services, Inc. (NPS).
- 2. On or about May 30, 2002, Respondent was charged in the state of in New Jersey under Complaint No. W232514 with two criminal counts and under Complaint No. W282550 with one count of "Theft by Failure to Make Required Disposition of Property Received." Respondent was charged with failing to remit in excess of \$75,000 in insurance premiums he collected to the Greater New York Mutual Insurance Company and in failing to remit in excess of \$75,000 in insurance premiums each that he collected from Garden Homes Inc., and Eliat Management Company.
