The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Theodore Basil Zogob ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as a non-resident Property/Casualty/Life/Health/Accident producer, Arizona license number 47101, which license expires August 31, 2004.
- 2. On or about July 30, 2002, the Texas Department of Insurance (TDOI) convened a hearing at which the Respondent was represented by counsel. The hearing was adjourned and the record closed on November 13, 2002.
- 3. On or about February 14, 2003, the TDOI made Findings that Respondent willfully violated the insurance laws of Texas; misappropriated, converted to his own use and illegally withheld money belonging to Casualty Reciropcal Exchange; engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices; and allowed Mitchell Zogob to directly or indirectly do acts which constitute the business of insurance without holding a license or other authorization to do so.

CONSENT TO ORDER

- Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as 4. expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
- 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
