

1 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any
2 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

3 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
4 examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

5 6. The Department holds a Workers' Compensation deposit in the amount of
6 \$1,285,000 on behalf of the Petitioner.

7 7. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the Insurance
8 Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

9 IT IS ORDERED that:

10 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

11 2. The Workers' Compensation deposit of the Petitioner in the amount of
12 \$1,285,000 shall be transferred to an account in the name of TIC with the Department,
13 and shall be held as a Workers' Compensation deposit of TIC.

14 3. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF
15 shall be released to Petitioner.
