**CONSENT ORDER**

On April 13, 2006, the State of Arizona, Department of Insurance (the "Department"), issued a Notice of Hearing in the matter of RICHARD MORTON GODFREY ("Godfrey"). Godfrey wishes to waive his right to a hearing and resolve this matter. Godfrey admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Richard Morton Godfrey ("Godfrey") was at all material times licensed as a non-resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 190792, which license expires December 31, 2006.

2. Godfrey's mailing address of record with the Department is: 4315 E. Everett Drive, Phoenix, AZ 85032 (business and residence).

3. On October 11, 2005, Godfrey filed a Clearance Letter Request Form notifying the Department that he was relocating to Georgia and requesting that his Arizona license be changed from resident to non-resident status.

4. On October 18, 2005, the Department issued a Clearance Letter canceling Godfrey's resident license and issuing a notification that the licensee's ability to transact insurance as a non-resident is contingent upon the licensee submitting a certification of license status from the new home state within 30 days of becoming licensed in that state.

16 contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this Consent  
17 Order, and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

18 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
19 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,  
20 officer or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be  
21 appropriate now or in the future nor does it preclude the Department from instituting civil or  
22 criminal proceedings as may be appropriate in the future.

23 6. Respondent agrees that if he fails to comply with the terms of this Consent  
24 Order, his nonresident insurance producer's license, Arizona license number 182505, is  
25 revoked.
