8 The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence
 9 that Jennifer Trinh Vo has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.").
 10 Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings,
 11 and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following
 12 Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 13 1. Jennifer Trinh Vo ("Vo") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident
 14 life, accident and health or sickness, variable life and variable annuity products, property and
 15 casualty producer, Arizona license number 851155 which expires March 31, 2009.
- 16 2. Vo's mailing, business and residence address of record with the Department is:
 17 9524 W. Camelback Rd., #130-322, Glendale, Arizona 85305.
- 18 3. On or about November 9, 2005, the Department issued Vo an insurance license
 19 as a resident life, accident and health or sickness, variable life and variable annuity products,
 20 property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 851155.
- 21 4. On December 22, 2005, the Department notified Vo by mail at her mailing,
 22 business and residence address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and
 23 returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested

1 a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement
2 Form" on or before January 26, 2006.

3 5. On February 17, 2006, the Department sent a second letter to Vo, return receipt
4 requested, notifying her that she had fifteen (15) days to submit a full set of fingerprints to the
5 Department.

6 6. The green card for the February 17, 2006 letter was signed by someone at Vo's
7 mailing/business/residence address of record and returned to the Department.

8 7. To date, Vo has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the Department.

9 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

10 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

11 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
12 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
13 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).

14 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
15 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

16 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
17 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
18 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

19 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
20 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
21 A.R.S. §§20-295(A)&(F).

- 3 1. Respondent's license shall be revoked.

18 Order.


19 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as

1 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
2 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter nor does it
3 preclude the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings not related to this matter
4 as may be appropriate now or in the future.
