**CONSENT ORDER**

On June 15, 2006 the State of Arizona, Department of Insurance (the "Department"), issued a Notice of Hearing in the matter of DONNA MARIE GIDEON ("Gideon"). Gideon wishes to waive her right to a hearing and resolve this matter. Gideon admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Donna Marie Gideon ("Gideon") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident life producer, Arizona license number 211116, which expires on December 31, 2008.

2. Gideon' residence address of record with the Department is: 9660 N. Antelope Meadows Drive, Prescott Valley, Arizona 86314. Gideon' mailing/business address of record with the Department is: c/o Primerica, 300 West Osborn Road, Suite 405, Phoenix, AZ 85013.

3. On or about October 11, 2005, the Department issued Gideon an insurance license as a resident life producer, license number 211116.

4. On or about December 8, 2005, the Department notified Gideon by mail at her mailing/business address of record that her fingerprint card was processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a

1 replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement  
2 Form" on or before January 11, 2006.

3 5. On February 17, 2006, the Department sent a second letter, certified mail,  
4 return receipt requested, to Gideon notifying her that she had fifteen (15) days to submit a  
5 full set of fingerprints to the Department.

6 6. The green card for the February 17, 2006 letter was signed by someone at  
7 Gideon' mailing/business address of record on February 21, 2006, and returned to the  
8 Department.

9 7. To date, Gideon has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the Department.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

12 2. Gideon's conduct as described above, constitutes the violation of the requirement  
13 that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of  
14 A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).

15 3. Gideon's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete  
16 information in the license application in violation of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

17 4. Gideon's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision  
18 of A.R.S. Title 20 within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

19 5. Grounds exist to suspend, revoke Gonzales's insurance license, or impose a  
20 civil penalty, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

21 **ORDER**

22 **IT IS ORDERED:**

23 1. Gideon is assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$ 100.00 due and payable  
24 upon return of the Consent Order.

25 2. Gideon shall complete a Voluntary Surrender of Insurance License form and  
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1 return it to the Department with this Consent Order.

6 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

7 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law  
8 and Order.

9 2. Respondent admits the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of  
10 Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the  
11 foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

12 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and a hearing at which it may be  
13 represented by counsel, present evidence and cross-examine witnesses. Respondent  
14 irrevocably waives her right to a hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent  
15 Order.

16 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature, except as expressly  
17 contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this Consent  
18 Order, and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

19 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
20 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,  
21 officer or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be  
22 appropriate now or in the future nor does it preclude the Department from instituting civil or  
23 criminal proceedings unrelated to this matter as may be appropriate in the future.


