CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

On August 25, 2006 the State of Arizona, Department of Insurance (the "Department"), issued a Notice of Hearing in the matter of MA DULCE TELLEZ ("Tellez"). Tellez wishes to waive her right to a hearing and resolve this matter. Tellez admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Ma Dulce Tellez ("Tellez") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident life producer, Arizona license number 855515, which expires on September 30, 2009.
- 2. Tellez's business and mailing address of record with the Department is: c/o World Financial Group Ins. Agency, Inc., 40 West Baseline Rd.,#107, Tempe, AZ 85238. Tellez's residence address of record with the Department is: 1995 South Ash St., Gilbert, AZ 85233.
- 3. On or about January 11, 2006, the Department issued Tellez an insurance license as a resident life producer, license number 855515.
- 4. On or about February 13, 2006, the Department notified Tellez by mail at her business and mailing address of record, return receipt requested, that her fingerprint card was processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI) as illegible. The

Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before March 21, 2006.

- 5. On April 4, 2006, the Department sent a second letter to Tellez, return receipt requested, notifying her that she had fifteen (15) days to submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department.
- 6. The green card for the April 4, 2006 letter was signed on April 13, 2006 by someone at Tellez's business and mailing address of record and returned to the Department on April 18, 2006.
 - 7. To date, Tellez has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 8. Tellez's conduct as described above, constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).
- 9. Tellez's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application in violation of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 10. Tellez's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 11. Grounds exist to suspend, revoke Tellez's insurance license, or impose a civil penalty, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295 (A), and (F).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Tellez is assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$ 100.00 due and payable upon return of the Consent Order.
 - 2. Tellez has completed a Voluntary Surrender of Insurance License form and

returned it to the Department with this Consent Order.

Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency, officer or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future nor does it preclude the Department from instituting civil or
