**ORDER RELEASING
RETALIATORY DEPOSIT**

Arizona Revised Statutes § 20-588 provides, in part, that deposited funds shall be released and returned to the Petitioner to the extent that such deposit is in excess of the amount required.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. United Services Automobile Association ("Petitioner"), a Texas domiciled insurer, was issued its certificate of authority to transact casualty without workers' compensation, marine and transportation, property and vehicle insurance in Arizona effective November 3, 1960.

2. In accordance with A.R.S. §§ 20-230 and 20-582(3), the Director ordered Petitioner to make a retaliatory deposit with the Arizona State Treasurer ("Retaliatory Deposit"). The approximate current balance of the Retaliatory Deposit is \$70,000 (Seventy thousand dollars).

3. Upon a review of all existing retaliatory deposits, the Arizona Department of Insurance determined that Petitioner's Retaliatory Deposit is no longer required pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-230 and that it is appropriate to release the Retaliatory Deposit to the Petitioner.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Director has no personal liability for the release of such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. § 20-588(B).
