

7	The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence							
8	that Mari Matis Bishop has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes							
9	("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal							
10	proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the							
11	following Conclusions of Law and Order.							
12	FINDINGS OF FACT							
13	1. Mari Matis Bishop ("Bishop" or "Re	espondent") is, and was at all material times						
14	licensed as a resident credit producer, Arizona license number 857596, which license expires							
15	January 31, 2010.							
16	2. Bishop's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Wells Fargo, 4669							
17	W. Broadway Blvd., Tucson, Arizona 85711 (business); 619 S. 6 th Ave., #10, Tucson, Arizona							
18	85701 (mailing and residence).							
19	3. On or about February 9, 2006,	the Department	issued Bishop an insurance					
20	license as a resident credit producer, license number 857596.							
21	4. On March 9, 2006, the Department notified Bishop by mail at her business							
	address of record, return receipt requested, that her fingerprint card had been processed and							



a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before April 14, 2006. The Post Office returned this letter to the Department as "Unclaimed".

- 5. On May 18, 2006, the Department sent a second letter to Bishop at her business address of record, return receipt requested, and to her mailing/residence address notifying her that she had fifteen (15) days to submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department.
- 6. To date, Bishop has not submitted a full set of fingerprints or the Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A)&(F).

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


1. Respondent's license shall be revoked.
