- 1. Petitioner, American Merchants Casualty Company, NAIC No. 43630, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Minnesota. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona on October 28, 1987.
- 2. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director in order to non-renew its personal lines automobile policies with Arizona policyholders effective September 20, 1993.
  - 3. Petitioner requested release of its Security deposit on August 28, 2006.
- 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

- 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
- 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
- 7. The Department holds a Security deposit in the amount of approximately \$600,000.00 (Six hundred thousand dollars) on behalf of Petitioner.
  - 8. Petitioner is entitled to the release of its deposit in the sum of \$600,000.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF shall be released to Petitioner.
  - 2. Petitioner's Security deposit shall be released to the Petitioner.
- 3. The Director has no personal liability for the release of such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. §20-588(B).
