Examiners for the Department of Insurance (the "Department") conducted a market conduct examination of United American Insurance Company ("UAIC"). In the Report of Targeted Examination of UAIC, the Examiners allege that UAIC violated A.R.S. §20-2533(C).

UAIC wishes to resolve this matter without formal proceedings, admits that the following Findings of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- UAIC is authorized to transact life and disability insurance pursuant to a
   Certificate of Authority issued by the Director.
- 2. The Director authorized the Examiners to conduct a market conduct examination of UAIC. The on-site examination covered the time period from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2005 and concluded on March 23, 2006. Based on their findings, the Examiners prepared the "Report of Targeted Examination of United American Insurance Company" dated December 31, 2005.
- 3. The Examiners reviewed the Company's Appeal Information Packet used by the Company during the time frame of the examination and found that the Appeal Information Packet did not include:

- 2. Within 90 days of the filed date of this Order, UAIC shall submit to the Arizona Department of Insurance, for approval, evidence that corrections have been implemented and communicated to the appropriate personnel, regarding the issues outlined in Paragraph 1 of the Order section of this Consent Order. Evidence of corrective action and communication thereof includes, but is not limited to, memos, bulletins, E-mails, correspondence, procedures manuals, print screens, and training materials.
- 3. The Department shall be permitted, through authorized representatives, to verify that UAIC has complied with all provisions of this Order.
- 4. UAIC shall pay a civil penalty of \$2,500.00 to the Director for deposit in the State General Fund in accordance with A.R.S. § 20-2508. The civil penalty shall be provided to the Market Oversight Division of the Department prior to the filing of this Order.
- 5. The Report of Targeted Examination of United American Insurance Company as of December 31, 2005, including the letter submitted in response to the Report of Targeted Examination, shall be filed with the Department upon the filing of this Order.
