FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Laurel Ann Gilmore ("Glimore") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 195495, which license expires June 30, 2008.
- 2. Glimore's mailing address of record with the Department is: clo Famers Insurance, 18444 N. 25th Ave., Phoenix, Arizona 85023. On August 31, 2007, Gilmore supplied the Department with a residence address of: 12308 Lamon Creet Dr., Lakeside, CA 82040.

4. On April 27, 2005, the Department notified Gilmore by mail at her mailing address of record, return receipt requested, that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "lilegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before June 1, 2005.

- 5. On July 5, 2005, the Department sent a second letter to Gilmore, return receipt requested, notifying her that she had fifteen (15) days to submit a full set of fingerprime to the Department.
- 6. The green card for the April 27, 2006 letter was signed by someone at Gilmore's mailing address of record and returned to the Department. The green card for the July 5.

 2005 letter was signed by Gilmore and returned to the Department.
- 7. The Department scheduled a hearing for revocation of Gilmare's Ilcanse, Docket Number 05A-145-INS.
- 8. On January 23, 2005, Gilmore sent a faxed copy of a Consent Order and faxed copy of a check for \$100. Based on the faxes it received, the Department vacated the hearing for Docket Number 05A-145-INS.
- 9. To date, Gilmore has not submitted a full set of fingerprints, the original Consent Order or original check for \$100 to the Department.
- 10. On July 24, 2007, the Department re-set a hearing and issued a Notice of Hearing for revocation of Gilmore's license.
