

1 3. On December 18, 2006, the Insurance Commissioner of Virginia approved
2 the merger of Petitioner into GLAIC.

3 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any
4 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

5 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
6 examination.

7 6. Petitioner's 2006 Annual Statement together with payment of all applicable
8 fees is due to this Department March 1, 2007.

9 7. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the Insurance
10 Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

11 IT IS ORDERED that:

12 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

13 2. Petitioner shall file its 2006 Annual Statement, together with payment of all
14 applicable fees.

15 3. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF
16 shall be released to Petitioner.
