The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Kristine Natividad** ("Natividad" or "Respondent") has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- Natividad is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident credit producer,
   Arizona license number 865810, which license expires May 31, 2010.
- 2. Natividad's business address of record with the Department is: 8075 S. River Parkway, Tempe, AZ 85284. Natividad did not provide a mailing address to the Department. Natividad's residence address of record with the Department is: 1840 W. Emelita Ave., Apt. 2156, Mesa, AZ 85202.
- 3. On or about May 15, 2006, the Department issued Natividad an insurance license as a resident credit producer, license number 865810.
- 4. On August 21, 2006, the Department notified Natividad by mail at her business address of record, return receipt requested, that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested

a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before September 26, 2006.

- 5. On December 6, 2006, the Department sent a second letter to Natividad, return receipt requested, at the same address, notifying her that she had 15 days to submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department.
- Someone at Natividad's place of business signed for the Department's
   December 6, 2006 letter.
- 7. To date, Natividad has not submitted a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A)&(F).

# **ORDER**

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license shall be revoked.
