ORDER

On May 22, 2007, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Lewis Kowal, issued an Administrative Law Judge Decision ("Recommended Decision"), received by the Director of the Department of Insurance ("Director") on May 23, 2007, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Director of the Department of Insurance has reviewed the Recommended Decision and enters the following Order:

- 1. The Recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are adopted.
- Petitioner may file its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona Corporation Commission.
- Petitioner is entitled to the release of its statutory deposit in the sum of \$100,000.00 and Petitioner's statutory deposit shall be released to Petitioner after the Department has received the following:
 - (a) A copy of Petitioner's Articles of Dissolution certified as having been filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission; and
 - (b) An official State Treasurer Receipt Form E101.

The Director of the Department has no personal liability for the release of such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided for in A.R.S. § 20-588(B).

- 4. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the IERF shall be refunded to Petitioner pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
- Petitioner shall file its 2007 Annual Statement with the Department, together with all applicable fees, unless Petitioner files its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona Corporation Commission on or before December 31, 2007.
- 6. Petitioner shall pay its 2008 Certificate of Authority renewal fee to the Department if Petitioner's Articles of Dissolution are not filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission on or before March 31, 2008.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 41-1092.09, Petitioner may request a rehearing with respect to this order by filling a written motion with the Director of the Department of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for relief under A.A.C. R20-6-114(B). Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, it is not necessary to request a rehearing before filing an appeal to Superior Court.

Petitioner may appeal the final decision of the Director to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166. A party filing an appeal must notify the Office of Administrative Hearings of the appeal within ten days after filing the complaint commencing the appeal, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-904(B).
