The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Amanda Kaye Orban** ("Orban" or "Respondent") has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Orban is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 865008, which license expires October 31, 2009.
- 2. Orban's business address of record with the Department is: c/o Michael Goldman Agency, 17235 N. 75<sup>th</sup> Ave., #C150, Glendale, AZ 85308. Orban's mailing/residence address of record with the Department is: 14830 N. Black Canyon Hwy., #1077, Phoenix, AZ 85053.
- On or about May 15, 2006, the Department issued Orban an insurance license as a resident property and casualty producer, license number 865008.
- 4. On August 21, 2006, the Department notified Orban by mail at her mailing/residence address of record, return receipt requested, that her fingerprint card had

been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before September 26, 2006.

- 5. On December 6, 2006, the Department sent a second letter to Orban, return receipt requested, at the same address, notifying her that she had 15 days to submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department.
  - 6. Orban signed for the Department's December 6, 2006 letter.
- 7. To date, Orban has not submitted a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form.
- 8. On July 24, 2007, the Department set a hearing and issued a Notice of Hearing for revocation of Orban's license.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2).
