ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

- Petitioner, Jefferson-Pilot Life Insurance Company, NAIC No. 67865, is a foreign insurer domiciled in North Carolina. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona on May 18, 1964.
- 2. Effective April 2, 2007, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into The Lincoln National Life Insurance Company (LNLIC), NAIC No. 65676, the surviving entity, a foreign insurer domiciled in Indiana. The surviving entity is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.
- 3. On February 14, 2007, the Insurance Commissioner of North Carolina approved the merger of Petitioner into LNLIC.

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
