- 2. On or about November 15, 2006, Respondent sent a letter to a potential client that states "We are approved by the Insurance Commissioner in Arizona for providing G3 Trusts." The Department does not approve or regulate trusts.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes violating any provision of this ARS Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).
