The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Eric Robert Schilling, ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Eric Robert Schilling ("Schilling") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life and property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 135116, which license expires August 31, 2009.
- 2. Between June and November 2006, Respondents forged clients' signatures on broker of record change forms.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes forging another's name to any document related to an insurance transaction, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(10).

- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- Respondent's license is suspended for 90 days effective immediately upon entry of this Order.
- 2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000.00 to the Director for deposit in the State General Fund in accordance with A.R.S. § 20-295(G). A down payment of \$1,250.00 will be due at the signing of the Consent Order and \$1,250.00 due the first of each month until paid in full beginning July 1, 2007.
