In 10 light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of 11 Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require 12 emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B). 13 FINDINGS OF FACT 14 1. Humberto Padilla Rodriguez ("Respondent") is licensed as a bail bond agent. 15 Arizona License Number 858506 which expires on March 31, 2009. 16 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: Yuma Bail Bonds. 17 217 S. 2nd Ave., Suite C, Yuma, Arizona 85364 (business); and 844 Ronald St., Brawley, 18 California 92227 (residence). 19 3. On February 9, 2007, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the 20 Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was cancelled on February 1, 2007. 21 22 23

1	4. On March 14, 2007, the Department sent Respondent a letter, return receipt
2	requested, at his business address of record, notifying Respondent that he had failed to
3_	maintain-a-surety-bond-as-required-by-law.
4	5. As of February 1, 2007, the Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of
5	this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.
6	6. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.
7	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
8	1. The Director has jurisdiction.
9	2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail
10	bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety
11	insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.
12	3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
13	41-1092.11(B).
14	<u>ORDER</u>
15	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:
16	Respondent's license is summarily suspended effective immediately.
