Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

1. Petitioner, Health Plan of Nevada, Inc., NAIC No. 96342, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Nevada. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact health care services insurance in Arizona on August 15, 1996.
2. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.
3. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.
4. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

1 5. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the Insurance  
2 Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

3 6. The Department holds an Escrow Reserve deposit in the amount of \$950,000  
4 and an Ordinary deposit in the amount of \$600,000 on behalf of Petitioner.

5 IT IS ORDERED that:

6 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

7 2. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF  
8 shall be released to Petitioner. The Director has no personal liability for the release of  
9 such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. §20-588(B).

10 3. Petitioner is entitled to the release of its Escrow Reserve deposit of \$950,000  
11 and its Ordinary deposit of \$600,000. Petitioner's deposits shall be released to the  
12 Petitioner. The Director has no personal liability for the release of such deposits so  
13 made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. §20-588(B).
