CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Fred E. Hintz ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident property, casualty, life and accident/health insurance producer, Arizona license number 7718, which license expires August 31, 2010.

2. Respondent was not licensed, at all material times, as either a resident or non-resident surplus lines broker.

4. Respondent is not exempt from licensure as either a resident or non-resident surplus lines broker or Mexican insurance surplus lines broker.

5. Over the past 12 months, Respondent placed surplus lines business with a licensed surplus lines broker.

3 2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$600.00 to the Director for  
4 deposit in the State General Fund in accordance with A.R.S. § 20-295(G), due upon entry of  
5 this Order.
