ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") has received evidence that Second Chance Bail Bonds dba A Second Chance Bail Bonds, Second Chance Immigration Services, A Second Chance Immigration Services and Syed Shahzad Ali ("Respondents") have unlawfully transacted the business of insurance in the State of Arizona. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 20-340.06 and 20-292.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Second Chance Bail Bonds dba A Second Chance Bail Bonds ("Second Chance Bail") is domiciled in Ohio as a registered trade name, registration #1326966. Second Chance Bail is not licensed as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Second Chance Bail is not exempt from licensure as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Second Chance Bail's mailing addresses are P.O. Box 603913, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 and P.O. Box 912, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223.
- 2. Second Chance Immigration Services dba A Second Chance Immigration
 Services ("Second Chance Immigration") is domiciled in Ohio as a registered trade name,

registration #1619619. Second Chance Immigration is not licensed as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Second Chance Immigration is not exempt from licensure as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Second Chance Immigration's mailing addresses are the same as Second Chance Bail.

- 3. Syed Shahzad Ali ("Ali") is owner of Second Chance Bail and Second Chance Immigration. Ali is not licensed as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Ali is not exempt from licensure as a bail bond agent in Arizona. Ali's residence address is 3582 Caleb Ave., Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221.
- 4. On October 21, 2005, Raul Atler ("Atler"), President of Gonzales & Gonzales Bond and Insurance Agency filed a complaint with the Department regarding several licensed bail bond agencies and other unlicensed business entities selling federal immigration bonds in Arizona. One of the entities Atler named was Second Chance Bail. Atler provided a website address and yellow pages advertisements for Second Chance Bail. The website advertises the services offered by Second Chance Bail as bail bonds and immigration bonds for detainees in Eloy and Florence, Arizona. The yellow page advertisement states that Second Chance Bail provides immigration bonds and services for "Any jail, any court, anytime, anywhere."
- 5. On November 4, 2005, an investigator for the Department contacted Ali advising him that he was transacting insurance in the form of immigration and bail bonds without the proper license.
- 6. On December 28, 2005, an investigator for the Department contacted Ali by phone. Ali stated that he did not write bail bonds or immigration bonds. Instead, Ali refers consumers to National Bonding & Insurance in Florida ("National Bonding"). Ali receives 5%

of the bond amount if the bond is written for making the referral to National Bonding. Eduardo F. Almeida, president of National Bonding stated that he stopped doing business with Ali in September, 2005.

- 7. Upon investigation, the Department discovered:
 - a. As of February 14, 2006, Second Chance Bail's website still contained a link that offers bail and immigration bonds in Arizona.
 - b. As of April 4, 2006, the website link still offered bail and immigration bonds with telephone numbers in Eloy and Florence, Arizona.
 - c. Ali has felony convictions in federal court in Ohio.
 - d. In August, 2005, National Bonding wrote an immigration bond for an Arizona indemnitor. National Bonding split its commission with Ali.
 - e. As of September 15, 2006, the website link for Second Chance Bail offered bail and immigration bonds with telephone numbers in Eloy and Florence, Arizona.
 - f. On January 26, 2007, the California Department of Insurance provided the Department with documents showing that Action Bail Bonds posted an immigration bond for Eloy detainee Fernando Montoya Gallardo on November 16, 2005. The documents show that Action Bail Bonds issued a check to Second Chance Bail on November 16, 2005 for \$400 for the Gallardo bond.
 - g. As of May 30, 2007, Second Chance Bail was still answering its Arizona phone number.

2. Respondents conduct, as alleged above, constitutes transacting insurance business in the State of Arizona without a license within the meaning of A.R.S. §§ 20-106, 20-

The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

- 3. Respondents conduct, as alleged above, constitutes acting as a bail bond agent in this state without a license within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(A).
- 4. Respondents conduct, as alleged above, constitutes accepting a commission, service, brokerage or other valuable consideration for selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in this state if that person is required to be licensed and is not so licensed, within the meaning of A.R.S. §§ 20-298(B) 20-340.06.
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to order Respondent to cease and desist its violation pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-292.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. Respondents shall immediately cease and desist from transacting insurance business, including that of acting as a bail bond agent, in the State of Arizona.
- 2. Respondents shall cease and desist accepting a commission, brokerage or other valuable consideration for selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in this state.

1	3. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and
2	effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.
