CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Richard Anthony Peters ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as a non-resident property, casualty, life, accident/health and variable annuities producer, Arizona license number 597178, which license expires November 30, 2009. Respondent's state of domicile is Nebraska.

2. On December 22, 2005, respondent entered into a Consent Order with the Nebraska Department of Insurance, Cause No. A-1649, wherein he was found to have been improperly withholding, misappropriating or converting any money or property received in the course of doing insurance business and using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business within the meaning of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§44-4059 (1)(b) & (d).

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CONSENT TO ORDER

1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.


2. Respondent admits the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.

4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
