- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident property, casualty, life and accident/health insurance producer, Arizona license number 149790, which license expires September 30, 2008.
- 2. Respondent is, and was at all material times contracted as a captive agent with Farmers Insurance Group (Farmers) to transact insurance on its behalf with her own agency office at 2135 Hwy. 95 #181, Bullhead City, AZ 86442.
- Between September 2006 and May 2007, Respondent failed to remit

 \$16,251.20 in premium to Farmers and/or used current cash premium payments to cover prior cash premium shortages.

- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-295(A)(8).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondents' insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).
