The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that Benicorp Insurance Company ("Respondent") violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent, a stock insurer, is domiciled in the State of Indiana and presently holds a certificate of authority in Arizona to transact life and disability insurance.
- 2. On August 9, 2007, the Marion Circuit Court, Marion County, State of Indiana ("Court"), issued an Order of Rehabilitation placing Respondent into rehabilitation pursuant to Indiana law. The Court appointed the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance as Rehabilitator and directed the Commissioner to take possession of Respondent's assets and administer them under the Court's general supervision. The Respondent consented to the entry of the Order of Rehabilitation.
- 3. The Court found that Respondent is currently in a financial condition that is hazardous to its policyholders, creditors or the public.
- 4. The Respondent failed to file its annual audited financial statement with the Department as required by A.R.S. § 20-223.

5. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action. A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent is in unsound financial condition or in such condition as to render its further transaction of insurance in this state hazardous to the policyholders or to the people of this state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 220(A)(3).
- 2. Respondent's failure to file its annual audited financial statement is a violation of A.R.S. § 20-220(A)(1).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED summarily suspending Respondent's Arizona certificate of authority and prohibiting Respondent from issuing any new or renewal business, effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This Order is an "appealable agency action". A.R.S. §41-1092. You have the right to appeal this order by filing a hearing request after you receive this notice. Your hearing request must identify the party appealing, the party's address, the action you are appealing or contesting and a detailed statement of the reasons for the appeal. In any event, your hearing will be held within 60 days after we receive your request for hearing, unless the

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hearing is advanced or delayed by agreement or a showing of good cause by any party and the Office of Administrative Hearing Calendar can accommodate the advanced or delayed date. The Department of Insurance will promptly serve you with a "Notice of Hearing" at least 30 days before the scheduled hearing that will inform you of the date, time and location of the hearing as well as the issues. A.R.S. §41-1092.05(E).

If you file an appeal, you may also request an "informal settlement conference" by filing a written request with the Department. You may request an informal settlement conference at any time but not later than 20 days before the scheduled hearing. We will hold the informal settlement conference at the Department within 15 days after our receipt of your request. If you request an informal settlement conference, a person with the authority to act on behalf of the Department will be present. Please note that you waive any right to object to the participation of the Department's representative in the final administrative decision of the matter if it is not settled. A.R.S. §41-1092.06.
