ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

Respondents.

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Respondents have unlawfully engaged in the business of insurance in the State of Arizona. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-401.02.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On February 14, 2007, Jewel Davis ("Davis") filed a complaint with the Arizona Department of Insurance regarding a health insurance policy purchased for two employees of Marick, Inc. dba Copy Works & Printing ("Copy Works & Printing"). The health insurance policy was solicited through a fax sent to Copy Works & Printing. Davis purchased the insurance through a Nevada producer, Mark Miller, who represented that the health insurance was a PPO.

- 2. Mark Miller is an employee of Family Healthcare Services, Inc. dba America's Best Benefits, an independent contractor enrollment firm that provides enrollment services for the National Trade Business Alliance of America¹, an association that purports to provide its members with a healthcare savings program called Affinity Health Plans of America.
- 3. For each employee, Davis received two cards for "Affinity Health Plans of America." One card was a "Medical Benefits" card but stated that it was for a Limited Benefit Insured Plan 100. The address for claims submissions was HCH, TPA, P.O. Box 841237, Houston, Texas 77284. The other card stated "This Program is not Insurance" and only provides dental, vision, prescription and chiropractic services on a discounted basis.
- 4. Mark Miller ("Miller" or "Respondent Miller") is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona nor is he exempt from the licensing requirement.
- 5. Family Healthcare Services, Inc. dba America's Best Benefits ("America's Best" or "Respondent America's Best") is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona nor is it exempt from the licensing requirement. America's Best Benefit's addresses are: 2515 Camino Del Mar #11, Del Mar CA 92014 and 5234 Kendall Ridge Court, Las Vegas NV 89141.
- 6. Ethan Erickson ("Erickson" or "Respondent Erickson") is President of America's Best Benefits. Erickson is licensed in Arizona as a non-resident life producer, license number 864105 which expires January 10, 2010. Erickson's addresses of record with the Department are: 5550 S. Fort Apache, Suite 108, Las Vegas, NV, 89148 (business) and 5234 Kendall Ridge Ct., Las Vegas, NV, 89141.
- 7. James Doyle ("Doyle" or "Respondent Doyle") is the Vice President of America's Best. Doyle is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona nor is he exempt from the licensing requirement.

- 8. National Trade Business Association ("NTBAA" or "Respondent NTBAA") is a membership association located at 141 Ganttown Road, Suite E, Turnersville, NJ 08012. NTBAA is not a bona fide association within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-2301(5). NTBAA is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona nor is it exempt from the licensing requirement. NTBAA issued health insurance contracts to Arizona residents in the form of insurance cards for Affinity Health Plans of America.
- 9. Thomas J. Sullivan ("Sullivan" or "Respondent Sullivan") is the President of NTBAA. Sullivan is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona nor is he exempt from the licensing requirement.
 - 10. Doyle is the Secretary and Treasurer of NTBAA.
- 11. Neither NTBAA or Affinity Health Plans of America holds a certificate of authority to transact insurance in the State of Arizona.
- 12. Neither NTBAA or Affinity Health Plans of America is exempt from the certificate of authority requirement.
- 13. HCH Administration, Inc. ("HCH" or "Respondent HCH") is a licensed third party administrator domiciled in New Mexico and holds Arizona license number 201589 which expires on June 30, 2009. HCH's address of record with the Department is 209 W R B Garrett Ave., Peoria, Illinois 61605.
- 14. Paylogix, LLC ("Paylogix" or "Respondent Paylogix") is a New York domiciled life and health administrator (NAIC # 2271) authorized to do business in Arizona. Paylogix is located at 1025 Old Country Road, Suite 310, Westbury, NY 11590.
 - 15. Richard Pfadenhauer is the Owner/Member of Paylogix.
- 16. On July 20, 2006, Paylogix entered into an Administrative Service Agreement with NTBAA. Sullivan signed the agreement as President of NTBAA.
- 17. On July 15, 2006, Paylogix entered into an Administrative Service Agreement with America's Best to administer Affinity Healthplan (sic) of America. Erickson signed the agreement as Vice President of America's Best.

- 18. On September 11, 2006, Paylogix, on behalf of Affinity Health Plans of America, made two withdrawals from the CopyWorks & Printing business account, **** **** 0116, each for \$249.50.
 - 19. As a result of its investigation, the Department discovered:
 - a. On May 22, 2007, the North Carolina Department of Insurance scheduled a hearing and issued an Order to produce documents to Sullivan, Doyle and Erickson alleging the transaction of unlicensed insurance business in that state (Docket # 1375).
 - b. On March 22, 2007 the Better Business Bureau issued a press release warning Washingtonians that Affinity Health Plans of America was a sham insurance plan offered by NTBAA.
 - c. On September 26, 2006, the Kentucky Office of Insurance issued a press release warning Kentuckians of a group health insurance scam being offered by NTBAA through another agent, PBC Direct.
 - d. On August 3, 2004, the Pennsylvania Department of Insurance entered a
 Consent Order with NTBAA, Docket No. CO 04-07-003, for violations of
 Pennsylvania statutes prohibiting the solicitation of unauthorized insurance.
 NTBAA was ordered to cease and desist doing business in Pennsylvania.
 - e. On December 13, 2002, the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Texas issued an ex parte Emergency Cease and Desist Order against Doyle for engaging in unlicensed activity in that state. On or about June 3, 2004, Doyle was indicted for selling bogus insurance products to Texas consumers.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Transact, with respect to insurance, includes solicitation and inducement, preliminary negotiations, effectuation of a contract of insurance and transaction of matters

subsequent to effectuation of the contract and arising out of it, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-106(A).

- 3. Respondents Miller, America's Best, NTBAA, Sullivan and Doyle's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in Arizona for any class or classes of insurance without a license for that line of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-282.
- 4. Respondents Miller, America's Best, NTBAA, Sullivan and Doyle are not exempt from licensure under A.R.S. § 20-283(B).
- 5. Grounds exist to issue a cease and desist order to Respondents Miller, America's Best, NTBAA, Sullivan and Doyle for selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in Arizona for any class or classes of insurance without a license for that line of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-292.
- 6. Respondent NTBAA is not a bona fide association in Arizona within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-2324 nor does NTBAA hold a certificate of exemption under A.R.S. § 20-401.05.
- 7. Respondent NTBAA's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes transacting insurance business in Arizona without a certificate of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-401.01(A).
- 8. Respondent NTBAA is not exempt from holding a certificate of authority under A.R.S. § 20-401.01(B).
- 9. Grounds exist to issue a cease and desist order to Respondent NTBAA for unlawfully transacting insurance business in Arizona without a certificate of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-401.02.
- 10. Insurance contracts issued by Respondent NTBAA are enforceable and valid contracts, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-402.

- 11. Respondents Erickson, HCH and Paylogix's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes aiding or assisting any person in the unauthorized transaction of insurance business in Arizona, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(11).
- 12. Grounds exist for the director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Respondents Erickson and HCH's licenses, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A) and (B).
- 13. Grounds exist for the director to impose a civil penalty upon Respondents Erickson and HCH of at least \$250 but not more than \$2,500 for each unintentional violation and at least \$2,500 but not more than \$15,000 for each intentional violation, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F).
- 14. Grounds exist for the director to suspend or revoke Respondent Paylogix's certificate of registration, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-485.12(H)(3).
- 15. Grounds exist for the director to impose a civil penalty upon Respondent Paylogix of at least \$1,000 but not more than \$10,000, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-485.12(I).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. Respondents Miller, America's Best, NTBAA, Sullivan and Doyle shall immediately cease and desist from offering or soliciting insurance applications, taking or proposing to make any insurance contract, taking or receiving any application for insurance, taking or collecting any premium, fees, commission, or any other consideration for any insurance contract, issuing or delivering insurance contracts to residents of Arizona, or otherwise offering or issuing insurance contracts to Arizona residents.
- 2. Respondent NTBAA shall immediately cease and desist from unlawfully transacting insurance business in Arizona without a certificate of authority.
- 3. Respondent NTBAA shall pay all valid claims arising out of acts covered by any and all insurance contracts issued by them to Arizona residents for so long as such claims may legally be brought against the contract holders.

- 4. Respondents Erickson, HCH and Paylogix shall immediately cease and desist from aiding or assisting any person in the unauthorized transaction of insurance business in Arizona.
- 5. Respondent Erickson shall report the final disposition of the administrative matter in North Carolina, Docket # 1375, within 30 days after the final disposition of the matter, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(A).
- 6. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

You are hereby notified that you may request a hearing to contest this Order. A.R.S. § 20-160. Your hearing request must be in writing and received by the Department within 30 days. Upon receipt of a timely written request for hearing, we will issue a Notice of Hearing informing you of the time and place for the hearing.

Once the hearing is scheduled, you may also request an Informal Settlement Conference ("ISC"). A.R.S. § 41-1092.06(A). You must request the ISC in writing no later than 20 days before the scheduled hearing. We will hold the ISC within 15 days after we receive your written request. The Director will have a person with the authority to act on behalf of the Department present. Any statements you make at the ISC, either written or oral, are inadmissible by us at the hearing. If your case is not settled, you waive all objections to the Department's representative participating in the final administrative decision of your matter. A.R.S. § 41-1092.06(B).
