- 4. Petitioner shall file its 2007 Annual Statement with the Department, together with all applicable fees, unless Petitioner files its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona Corporation Commission on or before December 31, 2007.

1 NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 41-1092.09, Petitioner may 3 request a rehearing with respect to this order by filling a written motion with the Director of the Department of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for relief under A.A.C. R20-6-114(B). Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, it is not necessary 6 to request a rehearing before filing an appeal to Superior Court. 7 Petitioner may appeal the final decision of the Director to the Superior Court of 8 Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166.
