2 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any  
3 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

4 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
5 examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

6 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the  
7 Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C.  
10 R20-6-303, relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

11 **ORDER**

12 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

13 2. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF  
14 shall be released to Petitioner.
