ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Petitioner, American Insurance Company of Texas, NAIC No. 81949, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Texas. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona on October 26, 1987.
- 2. Effective October 1, 2007, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Unified Life Insurance Company (ULIC), NAIC No. 11121, the surviving entity, a foreign insurer domiciled in Texas. The surviving entity is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.
- 3. On October 11, 2007, the Insurance Commissioner of Texas approved the merger of Petitioner into ULIC.
