No. 08A-016-INS CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Gary Morris Baker and Baker Associates Insurance Agency. Inc. ("Respondents") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, admit the following Findings of Fact are true, and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- Gary Morris Baker ("Baker") is, and was at all material times, licensed 1. as a life, accident and health producer, Arizona license number 155048, which expires on April 30, 2009. Baker's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Baker Associates Insurance Agency, 8444 N. 90th Street, Suite 110, Scottsdale, Arizona 85258 (business) and 36590 N. Boulder View Dr., Scottsdale, Arizona 85262 (residence).
- Baker Associates Insurance Agency, Inc. ("Baker Associates") is, and 2. was at all material times, licensed as a life, accident and health producer, Arizona license number 155049, which expires on June 30, 2011.1 Baker Associates'

address of record with the Department is 8444 N. 90<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 110, Scottsdale, Arizona 85258.

- 3. Baker was the only licensed insurance producer at Baker Associates from June 11, 2003 until December 5, 2005. All other employees of Baker Associates operated pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-283 and under the authority of Baker's insurance producer license.
- 4. Baker had a Direct Broker's Agreement with John Hancock Life Insurance Company ("John Hancock") to sell life insurance on John Hancock's behalf since on or about September 7, 2004.
- 5. On or about April 11, 2005, Baker Associates submitted a formal application for life insurance to John Hancock containing altered medical records.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 6. Respondents' conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 7. Respondents' conduct, as described above, constitutes knowingly presenting a written statement or document containing untrue statements of material fact or failure to state material facts with respect to an application for the issuance or renewal of an insurance policy or the rating of an insurance policy, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-463(A)(1).
- 8. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondents' insurance licenses, impose a civil penalty, and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A), (B), and (F).

# ORDER

- 1. Respondents are assessed a civil penalty in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) due and payable upon return of this Consent Order.
- 2. Respondent Gary Morris Baker's license, Arizona license number 155048, is suspended for a period of ninety (90) days effective immediately upon entry of this Order.

Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency, including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
- 6. Gary Morris Baker, as President of Baker Associates Insurance Agency, Inc., represents that he is authorized to sign and enter into this Consent Order on its behalf.
- 7. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
