FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

Respondent.

On July 9, 2008, the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") issued a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") in the above-captioned matter, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Notice required Respondent to provide a written answer to the allegations set forth in the Notice within twenty days of the issuance of the Notice. As of this date, Respondent has failed to file an answer. On July 31, 2008, counsel for the Department filed a Request for Default. As of this date Respondent has not responded to the Department's request. Pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-106(D), a party that fails to file an answer within the time provided shall be deemed to be in default and one or more of the allegations in the Notice of Hearing may be deemed to be admitted.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Notice was proper.
- 2. Respondent is in default.
- 3. The allegations in the Notice are deemed admitted.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent's conduct as described in the Notice constitutes failure of a surplus lines broker to file with the Director a notarized Semi-Annual Statement of all surplus lines business transacted by the broker during the period for which the statement is being filed, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-415.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 20-161 through and including 20-165 and 41-1092 et seq., through and including 41-1066, and 41-1092.01, the above-captioned matter will be heard before the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona ("Director") or her duly designated representative, on August 18, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. at the Office of Administrative Hearings ("Hearing"), 1400 West Washington Street, Suite 101, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, telephone number (602) 542-9826.

Motions to continue this matter shall be made in writing to the Administrative Law Judge not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date set for the hearing. A copy of any motion to continue shall be mailed or hand-delivered to the opposing party on the same date of filing with the Office of Administrative Hearings.

A.R.S. § 20-164(B) entitles any person affected by this Hearing to appear in person and by counsel, to be present during the giving of all evidence, to have a reasonable opportunity to inspect all documentary evidence, to examine witnesses, to present supporting evidence in support of his interests, and to have subpoenas issued by the Administrative Law Judge to compel attendance of witnesses and production of evidence.

If Respondent is represented by counsel, the attorney shall be licensed to practice law in the State of Arizona or, if applicant is an insurer, it may be represented by a corporate officer, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-161(B).

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.07(E), a clear and accurate record of the proceedings will be made by a court reporter or by electronic means. Any party that requests a transcript of the proceeding shall pay the cost of the transcript to the court reporter or other transcriber.

NOTICE OF APPLICABLE RULES

On January 23, 1992, the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") adopted A.A.C. R20-6-101 through R20-6-115, setting forth the rules of practice and procedure applicable in contested cases before the Director of Insurance. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to these rules.

PURSUANT TO A.A.C. R20-6-106, RESPONDENT SHALL FILE A WRITTEN ANSWER WITHIN 20 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE OF THIS NOTICE OF HEARING AND SHALL MAIL OR DELIVER A COPY OF THE ANSWER TO THE ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL DESIGNATED ABOVE. THE ANSWER SHALL STATE RESPONDENT'S POSITION OR DEFENSE AND SHALL SPECIFICALLY ADMIT OR DENY EACH ASSERTION IN THE NOTICE OF HEARING. ANY ASSERTION NOT DENIED SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE ADMITTED. ANY DEFENSE NOT RAISED IN THE ANSWER SHALL BE DEEMED WAIVED. IF AN ANSWER IS NOT TIMELY FILED, RESPONDENT SHALL BE DEEMED IN DEFAULT AND THE DIRECTOR MAY DEEM THE ALLEGATIONS ARE TRUE, AND TAKE WHATEVER ACTION IS APPROPRIATE, INCLUDING SUSPENSION, REVOCATION, DENIAL OF A LICENSE, OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE, IMPOSITION OF A CIVIL PENALTY AND/OR ORDER RESTITUTION TO ANY PARTY INJURED.

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES MAY REQUEST REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS SUCH AS INTERPRETERS, ALTERNATIVE FORMATS, OR

The allegations supporting this Notice of Hearing are as follows:

- 1. James Partick McErlean ("McErlean") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident life, property and casualty producer and surplus lines broker, Arizona license number 88630, which expires on March 31, 2009.
- 2. McErlean's address of record with the Department is: 863 S. Sabrina, Mesa, AZ 85208 (business/mailing/residential).
- 3. McErlean, as a licensed surplus lines broker, is required to file a Semi-Annual Statement and Tax Report ("statement") for each reporting period, and additionally remit the premium tax coinciding with the statement being filed.
- 4. For the reporting period of July 1 through December 31, 2006, ("reporting period"), McErlean was required to file the statement on March 1, 2007, and pay the accompanying tax on that date.
- 5. On or about June 20, 2007, the Department notified McErlean that he failed to timely file the statement and pay the tax for the reporting period.
- 6. On or about July 23, 2007, McErlean submitted a late surplus lines tax payment without submitting the required statement for the reporting period.
- 7. On or about October 5, 2007, the Department notified McErlean that failure to file the statement was a violation.
- 8. To date, McErlean has not submitted the statement for the reporting period ending December 31, 2006.

VIOLATIONS

- 9. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes failure of a surplus lines broker to file with the Director a notarized Semi-Annual Statement of all surplus lines business transacted by the broker during the period for which the statement is being filed, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-415.
- 10. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes failure of a surplus lines broker to remit the tax amount due as shown on the Semi-Annual Statement on or before the due date, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-416.
- 11. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes failure to comply with a requirement of Title 20, Chapter 2, Article 5, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-418(A)(1) and (B).
- 12. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew McErlean's surplus lines broker's license, impose a civil penalty, and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-417 and 20-418.

WHEREFORE, if after hearing, the Director finds the grounds alleged above, the Director may suspend or revoke Respondent's insurance license and order restitution, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-417 and 20-418.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-150, the Director of Insurance delegates the authority vested in the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona, to the Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings or her designee to preside over the hearing of this matter as the Administrative Law Judge, to make written recommendations to the Director of Insurance consisting of proposed findings of fact, proposed conclusions of law, and a proposed order. This delegation does not include delegation of the authority of the Director of Insurance to make the order on hearing other final decision this matter.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.01, your hearing will be conducted through the Office of Administrative Hearings, an independent agency. Please find enclosed a copy of the
