In 10 light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of 11 Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require 12 emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B). 13 **FINDINGS OF FACT** 14 1. Richard Jeremiah Rivera III ("Respondent") is licensed as a bail bond agent. 15 Arizona license number 199194 which expires on November 30, 2008. 16 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Affordable Bail 17 Bonds, 364 N. 1st Ave., Phoenix, Arizona 85003 (business); P.O. Box 93400, Phoenix, 18 Arizona 85070 (business); and 4620 North 78th Drive, Phoenix, Arizona 85033 (residence). 19 On December 10, 2007, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified 3. 20 the Department that Respondent's bail agent bond had been cancelled on December 5, 2007. 21 22 23

1	4.	On February 19, 2008, the Department sent Respondent a letter, return receipt	
2	requested, at his business address of record, notifying Respondent that he had failed to		
3	maintain a surety bond as required by law.		
4	5.	On February 26, 2008, the Department's February 19, 2008 letter was returned	
5	by the Post	by the Post Office as "Return to Sender – Attempted Not Known – Unable to Forward."	
6	6.	As of December 5, 2007, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this	
7	State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.		
.8	7.	The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.	
9		CONCLUSIONS OF LAW	
10	1.	The Director has jurisdiction.	
11	2.	Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail	
12	bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety		
13	insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.		
14	3.	Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §	
15	41-1092.11(B).

18	1.	Respondent's license is summarily suspended effective immediately.
