The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Tracy Sue Torngren has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Tracy Sue Torngren ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as 1. a resident life and variable life/variable annuities producer, Arizona license number 896766 which expires August 31, 2010.
- 2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: c/o AP Financial, 2730 W. Agua Fria Fwy, #203, Phoenix, Arizona 85027 (business); 2532 W. Village Drive, Phoenix, Arizona 85023 (residence).
- 3. On or about July 20, 2007, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident life and variable life/variable annuities producer, Arizona license number 896766.
- 4. On November 19, 2007, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her business address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before December 20, 2007.

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- To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
 Department.
- 6. On April 9, 2008, the Department set a hearing and issued a Notice of Hearing for revocation of Respondent's license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(F)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2).
- Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Respondent may surrender her insurance producer license, Arizona license number 896766.
- 2. The hearing, Docket # 08A-056-INS, scheduled for June 10, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. is vacated.
