Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Petitioner, Praetorian Specialty Insurance Company, NAIC No. 44776, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Delaware. Petitioner received its certificate of reinsurance accreditation to transact reinsurance in Arizona on March 30, 2001.
- 2. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of reinsurance accreditation to the Director.
- Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona or reinsurance agreements with Arizona domiciled insurers.

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- 4. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
- 5. The Department holds a workers' compensation deposit in the amount of \$120,000 on behalf of Petitioner.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Petitioner is entitled to a release of the workers' compensation deposit pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-588(A)(1).
- 2. The Director has no personal liability for the release of such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. § 20-588(B).

ORDER

- 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of reinsurance accreditation is accepted.
- 2. Petitioner is entitled to the release of its deposit in the sum of \$120,000. Petitioner's workers' compensation deposit shall be released to the Petitioner.
