CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Steven Scott Hurry and ISL Insurance Services, Inc, ("Respondents") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Steven Scott Hurry ("Hurry") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life and property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 342410, which license expires May 31, 2010.
2. Hurry is, and was at all material times owner and operator of ISL Insurance Services, Inc. ISL Insurance Services, Inc. was incorporated on May 15, 2007 which is licensed as an Arizona resident life and property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 892482, which license expires May 31, 2011.
3. Between May 15, 2007 and May 15, 2008, Respondents misappropriated client premiums and converted them to their own use.

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

3 2. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes a violation of any
4 provision of Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

5 3. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes improperly withholding,
6 misappropriating or converting any monies received in the course of doing insurance business,
7 within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(4).

8 4. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes using fraudulent, coercive
9 or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial
10 irresponsibility in the conduct of business within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8).

11 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
12 Respondents' insurance licenses, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
13 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

14 **ORDER**

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

16 1. Respondents' licenses are revoked effective immediately upon entry of this
17 Order.

1 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

2 1. Respondents have reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law

10 Consent Order.

11 4. Respondents state that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
12 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to them to induce them to enter into this
13 Consent Order and that they have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

14 5. Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
15 Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency,
16 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil
17 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

18 6. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action
19 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
20 (NAIC). Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to
21 any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this
22 administrative action on any license application.

1 7. Hurry represents that he is owner and operator of ISL Insurance Services,
2 Inc. and as such is authorized to enter this Consent Order on its behalf.
