CONSENT ORDER

Respondents

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Steven Scott Hurry and ISL Insurance Services, Inc, ("Respondents") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Steven Scott Hurry ("Hurry") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life and property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 342410, which license expires May 31, 2010.
- 2. Hurry is, and was at all material times owner and operator of ISL Insurance Services, Inc. ISL Insurance Services, Inc. was incorporated on May 15, 2007 which is licensed as an Arizona resident life and property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 892482, which license expires May 31, 2011.
- 3. Between May 15, 2007 and May 15, 2008, Respondents misappropriated client premiums and converted them to their own use.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes a violation of any provision of Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes improperly withholding. misappropriating or converting any monies received in the course of doing insurance business. within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(4).
- 4. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondents' insurance licenses, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. Respondents' licenses are revoked effective immediately upon entry of this Order.

- 5. Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency, including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
- 6. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
