Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Petitioner, Fidelity Mutual Life Insurance Company, NAIC No. 63304, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Pennsylvania. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona on June 5, 1964.
- 2. Petitioner was placed in rehabilitation on November 6, 1992 by the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania and suspended by the Arizona Director of Insurance on November 16, 1992.
- 3. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.

- 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.
- 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
- 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100,00 which has been credited to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-303(E), relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from the insurance business.

## ORDER

- 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.
- 2. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF shall be released to Petitioner.
