The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Marian Elizabeth Tokar dba A&M Bail Bonds ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 294861, which license expires October 31, 2008 and operated under the assumed business name of A&M Bail Bonds.
- 2. On February 28, 2006 The Superior Court of the State of Arizona in and for the County of Pima issued a direct indictment charging Respondent with two counts of money laundering in the second degree, a class three felony, in Cause No. CR20060784, for which she was arraigned and made subsequent appearances. Respondent failed to report this to the Department.
- 4. On February 15, 2007 The Superior Court of the State of Arizona in and for the County of Pima issued a direct indictment charging Respondent with two counts of money

laundering in the second degree, a class three felony, in Cause No. CR20070623, for which she was arraigned and made subsequent appearances. Respondent failed to report this to the Department.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the failure to report to the Director within 30 days after the initial pretrial hearing date, any criminal prosecution in any jurisdiction within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-301(B).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

#### **ORDER**

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license is revoked effective immediately upon entry of this Order.

- 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
