The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that United Benefits of America, LLC ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Timothy W. Thomas ("Thomas") is, and was at all material times licensed as a nonresident accident/health and life insurance producer, Arizona license number 888220, which license expires July 31, 2010.
- 2. Thomas is and was at all material times, owner and operator of United Benefits of America, LLC ("United Benefits"). United Benefits is a Tennessee limited liability company which is not licensed to transact insurance in Arizona.
- On or about July 7, 2008, the Department received evidence that United Benefits was transacting health insurance coverage with Arizona residents by phone through its call center.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. "Transact", with respect to insurance, includes solicitation and inducement, preliminary negotiations, effectuation of a contract of insurance and transaction of matters subsequent to effectuation of the contract and arising out of it, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-106(A).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in Arizona for any class or classes of insurance without a license for that line of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-282.
 - 4. Respondent is not exempt from licensure under A.R.S. § 20-283(B).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to issue a cease and desist order to Respondent for selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in Arizona for any class or classes of insurance without a license for that line of authority, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-292.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from offering or soliciting insurance applications, taking or proposing to make any insurance contract, taking or receiving any application for insurance, taking or collecting any premium, fees, commission, or any other consideration for any insurance contract, issuing or delivering insurance contracts to residents of this state, or otherwise offering or issuing insurance contracts to Arizona residents until it obtains the appropriate authority to do so from the Department.

- 2. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.
- 3. Respondent s shall pay to the Director a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500.00 immediately upon entry of this Order for deposit in the State General Fund.

Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that it must report this administrative action to any and all states in which it holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative Thomas represents that he is owner and operator of United Benefits of America.
