The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Erin Alejandrino** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Erin Alejandrino ("Alejandrino" or "Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health and life producer, Arizona license number 863980, which expires September 30, 2009.
- 2. Alejandrino's addresses of record are: c/o New York Life Insurance Company,
  One South Church Ave., Tucson, Arizona 85701 (business); 3225 E. Fairmount St., Tucson,
  Arizona 85716 (residence).
- 4. On July 10, 2008, Scott Weinstein of New York Life Insurance Company ("New York Life") notified the Department by mail that Alejandrino had been terminated for violating company policy with regard to the unauthorized use of non-public information. The letter stated that Alejandrino had admitted to using a customer's personal information (name, social security number and driver's license number) to establish an account in the customer's name

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with the local electric company. Alejandrina obtained the personal information in connection with an insurance transaction. New York Life also included a copy of the customer's complaint and Alejandrino's response.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8).
- 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

### **ORDER**

# IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. Respondent's insurance license, Arizona license number 863980, is revoked immediately upon entry of this order.

Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that will be reported to the NAIC and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications either to the Department or other states'

Departments of Insurance.
