ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Petitioner, Indianapolis Life Insurance Company, NAIC No. 64645, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Indiana. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona on September 20, 1968.
- 2. Effective September 30, 2008, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Aviva Life and Annuity Company (ALAC), NAIC No. 61689, the surviving entity, a foreign insurer domiciled in Iowa. The surviving entity is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.
- 3. On September 26, 2008, the Insurance Commissioner of Indiana approved the merger of Petitioner into ALAC.
