CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Peter Edward Vallejo ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/health, life, variable life and variable annuity insurance producer, Arizona license number 173563, which license expires January 31, 2012.
2. Respondent failed to respond to a demand for documents and an explanation of his actions regarding a complaint by Ms. Jean Guertin. The Department requested the information on June 18, 2008 and the due date was July 2, 2008.
3. On November 5, 2008, Respondent failed to respond to a Subpoena Duces Tecum for his Examination Under Oath and the production of documents regarding the complaint by Ms. Jean Guertin.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

1 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
3 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
5 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
6 officer, or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be
7 appropriate now or in the future nor does it preclude the Department from instituting
8 proceedings not related to this matter as may be appropriate now or in the future.

9 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
10 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).
11 Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
12 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
13 action on any license application.
