Title 20. In light of the 10 serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona 11 ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency 12 action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B). 13 **FINDINGS OF FACT** 14 Christina Anne Casteel ("Respondent") is licensed as a bail bond agent, Arizona 15 license number 892555 which expires on December 31, 2010. 16 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 16431 S. 34th Way. 17 Phoenix, Arizona 85048 (business); P.O. Box 93400, Phoenix, Arizona 85070 (mailing); and 18 1225 Stetson, Apt. A, Prescott, Arizona 86303 (residence). 19 3. On June 2, 2008, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the 20 Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled thirty days after May, 29, 21 2008 (June 27, 2008). 22

- 4. On July 8, 2008, the Department sent Respondent a letter at her mailing address of record, return receipt requested, notifying Respondent that she had failed to maintain a surety bond as required by law. The Post Office returned the green card to the Department with Respondent's signature dated July 16, 2008.
- 5. As of June 27, 2008, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.
 - 6. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction.
- 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.
- 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license is summarily suspended effective immediately.
