CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Karla Dennise Acevedo** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Karla Dennise Acevedo ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident credit producer, Arizona license number 919395 which expires September 30, 2011.

2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Wells Fargo, 8900 N. 7th Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85020 (business); 11629 W. Jackson Street, Avondale, Arizona 85323 (mailing and residence).

3. On or about May 15, 2008, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident credit producer, Arizona license number 919395.

4. On July 7, 2008, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her mailing/residence address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before August 5, 2008.

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent may surrender her insurance producer license, Arizona license number 991395.

2. The hearing, Docket # 09A-031-INS, scheduled for May 12, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. is vacated.



6 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
7 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
8 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
9 administrative action on any license application.
