Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the Director finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Petitioner, United Liberty Life Insurance Company, NAIC No. 82694, is a foreign insurer domiciled in Kentucky. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona on July 1, 1974.

2. Effective March 31, 2009, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Citizens Security Life Insurance Company (CSLIC), NAIC No. 61921, the surviving entity, a foreign insurer domiciled in Kentucky. The surviving entity is not authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner has voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.

3. On March 30, 2009, the Insurance Commissioner of Kentucky approved the merger of Petitioner into CSLIC.

1 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any  
2 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

3 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
4 examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

5 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the  
6 Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C.  
9 R20-6-303, relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

10 **ORDER**

- 11 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.  
12 2. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF  
13 shall be released to Petitioner.
