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
9 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 13 1. Petitioner is currently licensed in the State of Arizona as a casualty insurer.
 - 14 2. Petitioner surrendered its Certificate of Authority to the Department.
 - 15 3. Petitioner filed with the Department certified copies of Resolutions of the
16 Petitioner's Board of Directors and the Petitioner's shareholder(s) authorizing Petitioner to
17 withdraw from the insurance business by dissolution.
 - 18 4. Petitioner filed its certified financial statement as of November 16, 2009 with the
19 Department.
 - 20 5. Petitioner has no insurance obligations owing to it, whether by policies written
21 direct or by reinsurance ceded to it.
 - 22 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
23 ("IERF").

1 6. The Department shall refund to the Insurer the \$100.00 that was previously
2 credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
