CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Doyle William Deane McCurley ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident, bail bond agent, Arizona license number 50773, which expires May 31, 2012.
2. On February 25, 2010, Respondent failed to post the premium rates of the surety insurer he represents in a conspicuous manner at his place of business.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of the requirement that every bail bond agent shall post the premium rates of the surety insurer he represents in a conspicuous manner at his place of business, within the meaning of R 20-6-601(E)(1)(b).

1 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of any rule,
2 within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2), as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-
3 340.06.


4 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
5 Respondents' insurance licenses, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
6 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

7 **ORDER**

8 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**

9 1. Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00 for
10 deposit into the general fund.

3 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
4 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
5 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
7 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
8 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil
9 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

10 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
11 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
12 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
13 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
14 action on any license application.
