FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Nationwide Life and Annuity Company of America ("Petitioner") is a Delaware domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective October 6, 1982.
- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Nationwide Life and Annuity Insurance Company (NLAIC), NAIC No. 92657, the surviving entity, an Ohio domiciled insurer effective December 31, 2009. NLAIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Delaware approved the merger of Petitioner into NLAIC on December 18, 2009.
- 4. Petitioner has no insurance obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.
- 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
