- 3. On or about October 29, 2008, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident life producer, Arizona license number 931226.
- 4. On January 5, 2009, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her business/mailing address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before February 9, 2009.

On November 23, 2009, the Department notified Respondent a second time by


mail at her residence address of record that it was about to initiate an administrative action
